- Commitment to social justice
- Experience teaching or working with young people
- Experience, comfort, and/or openness to facilitating dialogue on sometimes sensitive topics
- Ability to perform and teach in English and in Spanish (*for some programs/casts*)

We strongly encourage those who reflect the communities we serve to apply, including bilingual individuals and/or people of color. A teaching or arts degree is not required. Other relevant experience will be considered.

Requirements:

- Must be available between 7am and 1pm weekdays during school year with minimal conflicts.
- Reliable transportation and ability to transport props/sets essential.
- Requires ability to tour to schools in self-directed manner; arriving punctually and reliably
- Requires excellent communication skills and timely responses to electronic communication
- Must complete required background check and clearance, provide references and fill out job application available at creativeaction.org/get-involved/jobs.
- Rehearsals begin mid to late-August or sooner depending on actor-teacher availability.
- Ongoing attendance at Creative Action trainings throughout the school year is also required.

Schedule/Calendar Details:

All actor-teacher positions are part-time, about 10-20 hours each week, usually 3 weeks per month, as shows are able to be booked. Holidays and school vacations off.
