



Creative Action 2021-2022 Day Camp FAQ

Registration

How do I register for day camps during the 21-22 school year?

What is the cost of Day Camp?

Each Day Camp is \$70 per student per camp. The full fee is due at the time of registration.

Cancellations?

There are no refunds offered after one week prior to the start of the program.

Are there late pickup fees?

Yes. Parents should make every effort to pick up their children before 5:30 PM. Please consider weather and traffic conditions when making your pick up arrangements.

If a child is not picked up by the end of camp.

1. A late pick-up fee of \$25.00 will be charged for every 15 minutes past 5:30 PM.
2. When parents arrive after 5:30 PM, the sign-out form will be sent to the Creative Action office so that the late pick-up fee can be processed.
3. Late pickup fees will be charged to your online account.

Who can enroll?

Day Camps serve students ages 5-11 years old. Select campuses will serve 4-year-old youth if Creative Action has a licensed pre-k program on the campus. Please refer to the sign up link for more information.

Creative Action day camps are open to all students at that campus - you do not have to be enrolled in after school to enroll in a day camp. In some cases, enrollment will also be open to students from the neighboring school if they share the same student holiday. Day camps at the Center for Creative will be open to all youth.

Do you offer a sibling discount?

Creative Action does not offer sibling discounts.

How do I get a tax receipt from last year?

Please email your request to enrollment@creativeaction.org. Be sure and include your student's name, campus, and the program you need receipts for (i.e. after school, summer camp, spring break camp, or day camps).

Programming and Schedule Questions:

Where do day camps take place?

Day camps will take place on school grounds or at the Creative Action building. See exact dates and locations posted at creativeaction.org.

What is the daily schedule?

The hours of operation for day camps are 9:00 am - 5:00 pm. Students can be dropped off as early as 8:30 am and picked up no later than 5:30 pm. Please notify the site coordinator via email or text if you will drop off your child after 10:00 am. Late fees will be accrued for any student signed out after 5:30 pm.

What does my child need to bring?

Please provide a sack lunch, plus a morning and afternoon snack. Refrigeration and microwaves will not be available. You may also pack a water bottle and any sunscreen or bug spray that your child may need. Please label all belongings.

Is there a COVID-19 safety protocol?

Keeping our students, staff, and families healthy and safe is important. All students and staff will be required to wear a mask. We ask that any person dropping off or picking up their child also wear their mask while at the sign in and out station. Regular handwashing procedures will be built into the schedule and staff will be responsible for cleaning and disinfecting tables and frequently used materials.

For the safety and health of all our children and teachers, sick children need to be at home. Please do not send your child to the program if s/he is experiencing any symptoms of infectious illness, including, but not limited to, fever within the previous 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications, cough, sore throat, etc. Additionally, please do not send your child to programming if they have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days. Students who recently tested positive for COVID-19 can return to programming 10 days after the start of symptoms, they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication, and their symptoms have improved.

Parents/guardians are required to notify Creative Action immediately if their child attended a day camp and tested positive for COVID-19.

Can I bring food with nuts?

Yes. A designated table will be provided to students with peanut or tree nut allergies. Parents will be notified if specific foods are not allowed due to severe allergies.

What does my child need to wear?

Students should wear comfortable clothing that allows them to move and get messy. Layering is recommended, as students will participate in indoor and outdoor activities. **Closed-toe shoes are highly encouraged (tennis shoes are recommended) to ensure student safety.**

Do you take field trips or go swimming?
