Our onsite, licensed after school program engages students in visual art, filmmaking, music, creative writing, acting, and more to deepen connections to lessons learned in the classroom—all while expanding the development of social and emotional skills.

WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT?

On average, Creative Action students showed a 22% increase in essential Social Emotional Learning competencies from the beginning of the school year to the end of the year.

Data from Austin ISD also shows that students in Creative Action had on average 67% fewer disciplinary actions than their peers.

Satisfaction surveys show families and campus leaders love our programs, with 99% of respondents in annual surveys agreeing they would recommend Creative Action to others.

ABOUT OUR TEACHING ARTISTS

Teaching Artists are offered 100+ hours of training per school year which includes positive behavior strategies, classroom management, and anti-bias and conflict resolution techniques. Teaching Artists encourage students to build connections among each other and with their community.

We assess and ensure program quality through internal and external Weikart Center for Youth Program Quality (YPQ) Assessments.
